Please make reservations at least 2 days in advance by calling 839-7603. Bus service is available if you are a Florissant Resident. *We will play Bingo each day after lunch.*

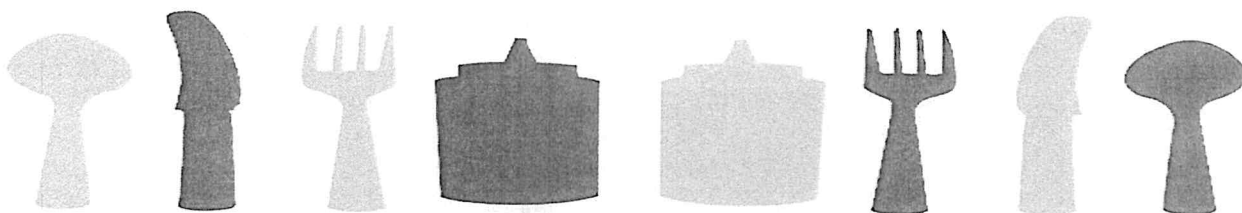

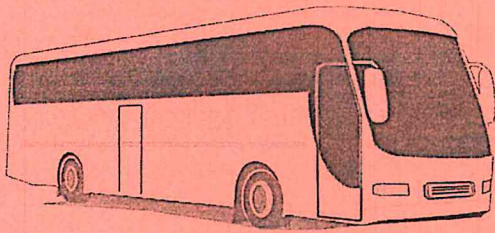
Friday, JANUARY 7: CANNOLIS: Pasta con broccoli, salad & bread
