## What Is Prop A?

Proposition A will be on the ballot Tuesday August 2nd. It is a 20-year general obligation Bond Issue for Aquatic Recreational Projects. It requires a 4/7th majority to pass.

If passed it will generate \$10 million for major new improvements and renovation of Florissant's aquatic recreation facilities. Proposition A will fund modern state-of-the-art aquatic facilities and upgrades for competition and wellness for our community. Even with the best maintenance swimming pools have a life

span. Providing upgraded and modern recreational facilities enhances the overall desirability of Florissant as a city that is moving forward.

The general obligation bond is based on the assessed value of one's home. For example, for a \$10 million general obligation bond financing, the tax rate would be approximately 12 cents. The cost to an average \$150,000 homeowner would be approximately \$2.85 per month..

As the largest city in the county, rebuilding and improving facilities allows for increased amenities to make the overall pool and aquatic experiences more enjoyable for all ages.
