A PLAQUE DEDICATION TOOK PLACE FOR JOHN (JACK) WEIDINGER WEDNESDAY, JULY 31ST



The City of Florissant held a Plaque Dedication with the Florissant Old Town Partners on Wednesday, July 31st. This was the 63rd plaque along St. François Walk Thru History Plaque Dedication Program. This program was designed to recognize those individuals who have made valuable contributions to the wholesome fabric of our beautiful City of Florissant and North St. Louis County.
